STATEMENT OF FAITH

We are a fellowship of Officers, believers in the Lordship of Jesus Christ. We are not a denominational organization, nor are we opposed to denominations as such; only to their over-emphasis of the doctrinal differences that have led to the division of the Body of Christ.

We Believe...

GOD: We believe that God is eternally existent in three separate persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
1 John 5:8 Matthew 28:19

GOD the FATHER: We believe that God, the Father, is the personal, transcendent, and sovereign Creator of all things.

GOD the SON (Jesus Christ): Jesus Christ is God incarnate. We believe that Jesus Christ is fully God and fully human, that he was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, provided for the atonement of our sins by His vicarious death on the cross, was bodily resurrected by the power of the Holy Spirit, ascended back to the right hand of God the Father, and ever lives to make intercession for us. *Luke 1:26-35; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, John 1:1-2,14; John 14:6*

GOD the HOLY SPIRIT: After Jesus ascended to Heaven, He poured out His Holy Spirit on believers in Jerusalem, enabling them to fulfill His command to preach the Gospel to the entire world; an obligation shared by all believers today. *John 14:16-17, 26*

THE BIBLE: We believe in the inerrancy of Scripture; that the Bible (Old and New Testaments) is the inspired, infallible Word of God.
2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21

MAN: We believe that ALL people are by nature separated from God and responsible for their own sin, but that salvation, redemption, and forgiveness are freely offered to all by the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Bible says in, *Romans 3:23 "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."* We are ALL sinners. By the Lord Jesus Christ's death upon a cross, He made a perfect atonement for sin, redeeming us from the curse of the Law by becoming a curse in our place. *Galatians 3:13*

SIN: All conduct should clearly reflect a conformance to the nature of Christ, our faith in Him, and to His word, abhorring behavior detestable to God as outlined in the Holy Bible. This includes, but is not limited to such behaviors depicted as follows: "Neither the sexually immoral nor idolators nor adulterers nor male prostitutes nor homosexual offenders nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God."

JUDGEMENT: Those who reject the love of God, and the saving work of the cross of Jesus Christ will be judged and punished for sin. They will be eternally separated from God. *John 16:7-11; Jude (1):14-15; John 3:18*

SALVATION: When a person repents of sin and accepts Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior, trusting Him to save, that person is immediately born again and sealed by the Holy Spirit, all of his/her sins are forgiven, and that person becomes a child of God, destined to spend eternity with the Lord. We are saved by grace and not by our own works. Eternal life is a **FREE GIFT** and **cannot** be earned.

LIFE: By placing our faith in Jesus Christ and submitting to Him as our Savior and Lord, we are considered as righteous in the sight of God. The guilt of our sin is all forgiven.
